It was a cast of his own car. »The Crash Porsche« followed in 2001. For the exhibition »Pure and Mixed States« in the Kunsthaus Bregenz in 2006 Gottfried Bechtold showed the group of sculptures »Eleven Eleven«. These were eleven casts of the then current prototype for the Porsche-911 series.
